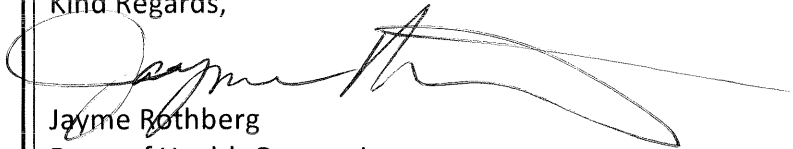
Dear Mr. Herman,

As per our previous discussion, I have listed the key points of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Center for Emergency Medical Services Education (CEMSE) and the Pasco-Hernando Community College Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Programs.

1. Evaluate and assess the Center's EMT students in accordance with the standards for the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) on an annual basis.
2. Assist with curriculum development and program collaboration.
3. Provide a field observation experience with PHCC's EMT program.
4. Maintain open lines of communication between programs, on a quarterly basis, or as needed.
5. Issue a Certificate of Completion for each student successfully passing the assessment and evaluation examinations performed by PHCC faculty.
